The VSP® Prediabetes A1C Screening Pilot training will be provided through Premier Academy360™, VSP's eLearning platform, allowing you to take these short courses when it's convenient for you. The training courses provide an overview of the pilot process and patient experience, performing A1C screening tests, as well as the administrative tasks of the pilot. We recommend that you and at least one person from your staff complete the courses. Completion of the training is required prior to beginning the pilot in your practice.

- Allocate time to discuss the pilot with the entire office prior to launch to ensure everyone understands their role.
